Tuesday, March 17 — Psalm 37:16–22
Exodus 23:27–25:9; Matthew 24:36–44

Questions for Reflection on Exodus 23:27-25:9:

- The instructions to God’s Chosen People assume an agrarian culture. What are the “first fruits” of your labor? How are they offered to God?
- Who are the angels—messengers of God—through whom we receive trustworthy wisdom and counsel?
- The Israelites are warned not to bow down to worship foreign gods. What might have tempted them to do so? What are the “false gods” in which we may be tempted to put our trust? How do we continue to trust the God revealed, especially, in Jesus’ cross and resurrection, in these anxious times?

God of wisdom, we long to be trustworthy and obedient disciples. May we never outgrow your guidance or become complacent with our knowledge of you. Instill in us a desire to seek your wisdom for all our days. Amen.
